Not to be missed!

Welcome to Chamonix valley!

At the crossroad of Switzerland and Italy, Chamonix is the worldwide capital for skiing and mountaineering. Surrounded by its ski resorts spread out on the 4 sides of the valley, most part of the ski area is above 2000 m².

Discover the typical villages of the valley: Servoz, Les Houches, Argentière and Vallorcine !

Also discover :

Aiguille du Midi



Glide up comfortably with the cable car into the high mountains, and reach an altitude of 12604 feet!

After a 25 minutes journey, you will enjoy a spectacular view all around you over the Mont Blanc and the French, Swiss and Italian Alps.

Discover:

The Mont-Blanc wing: enjoy an incredible panoramic view from inside, in a warm space, through vast glass windows, over Mont Blanc, Mont Maudit and Mont Blanc du Tacul! Also discover great photos of mountaineers in action! The waiting area: discover an incredible adventure of human and technological endeavor:

the construction of the cable car and its imposing machinery.

The highest covered area: this shelter built on the highest terrace at 3842 m gives you the opportunity to hide from the wind and the cold while enjoying a stunning view! The museum ("Espace vertical"): like a temple dedicated to climbers, mountaineers and mountain adventurers. It gives you a better understanding of the captivating high mountain world.

The Step into the void: an unforgettable experience! More than 1000m of emptiness beneath your feet in a 2m x 2m five-sided glass box!

The Hypoxia platform: discover how your body reacts to the lack of oxygen due to the altitude.

The Tube: this 32m long steel gallery allows you to make a complete tour of the central pillar of the Aiguille du Midi.



Mer de Glace



Facing the Drus and the "Grandes Jorasses", the Mer de Glace is the longest glacier in France.

From Chamonix, enjoy a marvellous 20 minutes' ride on board of the famous small red rack and pinion train up to Montenvers area at 1913 m.

Also discover:

- The "Glaciorium": this modern interactive space will give you a better understanding of how glaciers form, exist and evolve over the centuries.
- The Ice Cave: enter the entails of the glacier and admire ice sculptures!

To reach the entrance, you will have to take a cable car and walk down about 580 steps.

- The snowshoeing trails: open according to the snow conditions.

Mont-Blanc Tramway



A journey in a rack and pinion train up to the splendid Plateau de Bellevue through the forests and snow-covered slopes.

An unusual access to Les Houches – St-Gervais ski area, as well as to a snow shoeing trail!

Enjoy the panoramic view over the Bionnassay glacier, the Chamonix and Les Contamines valleys!


Mountain risk pole:

Getting around in the valley!

By train with Mont-Blanc Express



The SNCF railway line serves all villages from Saint-Gervais-Le Fayet until Le Châtelard on the Swiss border, going through Servoz, Les Houches, Chamonix, Argentière and Vallorcine.

One train approximately every hour.

Free journeys between Servoz and Vallorcine with the "guest card" (carte d'hôte).

Trains are also free from or until Saint-Gervais-Le Fayet train station with the Mont Blanc Unlimited pass.

When there are works on the railway line, buses instead of trains run between Vallorcine and Saint-Gervais-Le Fayet.

By bus





A regular urban transport serves the valley between Servoz and Le Tour villages.

Free access during the day with the "guest card" or with a ski pass:

- free between Le Tour and Les Houches with a Mont Blanc Unlimited pass;
- free between Le Tour and Chamonix with a Chamonix Le Pass.

Overnight, the **Chamo'nuit** shuttle between Argentière and Les Houches is a pay shuttle.

Ticket fare: 3€ a day or 2€ overnight with the Chamo'nuit shuttle.

"Le Mulet" in Chamonix

The electric "Le Mulet" free shuttles run around the town center every 30 minutes from 8am to about 7pm.

Wait at one of "Le Mulet" bus stops and let's go!

A map of "Le Mulet" tour is available in all tourist offices of the valley.

This "**on-demand transport**" service grants you the possibility of travelling through the whole Chamonix valley.

Reserved to people with a disability greater than or equal to 80%.

However, if you are not in that case, you still can benefit from the subscription to this service!

You will need to meet at least 3 of the following conditions:

- Be over 70 years old on the date of your subscription;
- Have your home far away from a public transport line, bus or train;
- Need to go to activities organized by the villages;
- Have a disability card, whatever the percentage;
- Have difficulty getting around on your own in winter (seasonal card).

Registration at the Chamonix Sud bus station.

How does this work?

 1 – Become first a member of the service for a period of 1 year: the subscription costs 10€.

Then, if you don't have any free transportation ticket (resident card, guest card), pay 3€ for a one-day return journey;

2 – Book your journey no later than the day before, before 5 pm or 4 hours before, according to availability, by phone at 0033 4 50 53 05 55.

For weekends and Mondays, please book no later than Fridays.

 3 – A minibus will be sent on the set day as close as possible to your home or to a defined stopping point and at the time confirmed by the reservation service. Arrive there **5 minutes before** the time set by the reservation service;

4 – Let you be driven to your destination ;

5 – For the return trip, pick-up will also be at a defined point at a time set up when confirming your reservation.

When can I use this service?

Available all year round from Monday to Sunday from 8:30 am to 12 pm and from 2 pm to 5 pm.

Where can I go?

Depending on the reasons of your journey, you can systematically use this service between your area and a point in the territory of the Community of Communes already served by the classic network:

- For shopping on the market, in the super markets and the local shops;
- For medical reasons: hospital, medical center, pharmacy;
- To go to the EHPAD, that is the home for older and dependent people;
- To carry out administrative procedures;
- To go to a cultural, sport or local life center.

By foot! Where to park?

The best way to enjoy stunning views of the panorama is to leave your car in one of the car parks of the valley. You will get 1 hour free of charge in most Chamonix car parks, for example in the indoor Saint-Michel, Mont-Blanc and Entrèves car parks!

In Chamonix:



- Grépon pay car park at the entrance of the town behind the Aiguille du Midi cable car, close to a bus and Mulet stop;
- 3 underground pay car parks;
- 4 outside pay car parks.

Two pay car parks located 200m away from the Chamonix Tourist Office have places for people with reduced mobility:



- **The Outa car park** (car park with barriers) has two places for people with reduced mobility.

To go and visit the Tourist Office from this car park, go on the path on the right side of these car park places, continue in front of the public toilets and then along the car park. At the end of the car park, continue straight away on the pavement along the Mont-Blanc hotel and its restaurant "Le Matafan".

You will find the Tourist Office just after the hotel on your left side;

- The underground Saint-Michel pay car park has places for people with reduced mobility on the 1st, 3rd and 5th floors: access with a lift only to these floors.

To reach the Tourist Office from this car park,

please go on the bridge located at the pedestrian exist of the car park,

then go down on the access ramp on the left side of the church, continue straight away in front of the Mountain House (Maison de la Montagne) until a second access ramp.

This ramp will directly lead you to the Tourist Office.

In Les Houches:

Free car parks in Le Tourchet and Le Prarion.

A free car park place for people with reduced mobility is available in front of the souvenirs shop "Le Floch'on" located on the side of the post office, across the tourist office.

In Argentière:

Les Fiz car park, a free car park at the very end of the village:

- on your right side if you arrive from Chamonix
- on your left if you arrive from Vallorcine.

In Vallorcine:

a specific car park place for people with reduced mobility is to be found on the left side of the office about 20 m away from the entrance door situated in front of the office.

Vehicles with a visible handicapped sticker are allowed to stay for free on Le Buet car park, on the car park close to the cable car and on the one on the side of the tourist office.

The guest card ("carte d'hôte")



The guest card allows you **to go for free in the whole Chamonix valley** - by bus and train from Servoz to Vallorcine **during the day.**

With this card, you will also get a discount at the swimming pool, the ice rink, for cross country skiing, in the museums of the valley, for car park subscriptions...

It will be **given to you for free by your accommodation provider** at your arrival!

If you are hosted for free, you can get this card for 10€ per week in the tourist offices.

* Note:

The free travel offer on the local train is only valid for a journey beginning and ending in the Chamonix valley, between Servoz and Vallorcine.

Outside this area, the SNCF (the French train line company) requires each passenger to have a valid ticket for the entire journey!

Sports and leisure activities Outdoor activities

Here are some ideas for activities beside downhill skiing:

- Dog sledging,
- Ice climbing,

- Snowshoeing or walking on groomed trails,

Ski resorts

High altitude ski areas:

Les Grands Montets ski resort



A mythic ski area on northern face.

The spot "par excellence" for off-piste skiing and free riding, partially on a glacier, open until the beginning of Mai.

A great snow park, a filmed and timed boarder cross.

A DVA park is also available there!

An easy ski area is open on "Plateau de Lognan", but its access is only possible from the arrival of Plan Joran cable car over a blue slope.

Therefore, this area is not recommended to the very beginners for whom it will be easier to start below on Les Chosalets beginner area.

No access to pedestrians as well as to snow shoeing walkers!

• Brévent – Flégère ski resort



«Sunshine» ski area facing the Mont Blanc range.

The southerly slopes of this resort make it a favorite for sunloving skiers.

The view on the Mont-Blanc range is exceptional.

On Brévent ski area:

- 1 beginner area in Planpraz;
- 1 filmed and timed slalom stadium as well as 1 big Air Bag.

On Flégère ski area:

- Mont Blanc Legend: free access. Games, barbecue, zip-line. Tables for picnic;
- 1 boarder cross;
- 1 timed speed piste.

Snowshoeing walkers will enjoy nice snowshoeing loops:

- 2 loops below the arrival of Flégère cable car;
- 1 loop at the arrival of Index cable car above Flégère.

Balme Le Tour-Vallorcine ski resort



Skiing between high mountain pastures and forests on the Swiss border.

Access to this area:

- from Le Tour village or
- from Vallorcine village.

You will discover there one of the biggest freestyle spaces of Europe!

On the Vallorcine side, Balme resort offers wide and gentle slopes through a forest of spruces.

• Les Houches ski resort



A large diversity of slopes and atmospheres based on the legendary Kandahar downhill slope.

Access to the pistes:

- with Bellevue cable car;
- with Prarion cable car;
- from Col de Voza or Bellevue stations of Mont-Blanc tramway.

2 snowshoeing trails and one loop for cross-country ski (skating only) at the top of Prarion cable car.

For children: the **ski camp** is to be found after a 10 minutes' walk above the arrival of the Prarion cable car:

- Sledging slopes,
- Snowtubing runs,
- Zip wires.

Free car parks at the bottom of each cable car.

Wheel chairs are not allowed on Bellevue cable car! They are allowed on Prarion cable car as well as on the Tramway du Mont Blanc!

Ski areas for beginners in the valley

A very sunny ski area with plenty of snow in Le Tour village. Perfect for beginners and medium-level skiers. Ideal for children (day-care center from 3 years old) and for beginners in snowboarding.

From there, enjoy a beautiful view over the piste and the glacier. **Free car park** at the bottom of the ski area.

Right in the middle of Chamonix, at the bottom of Le Brévent. Ideal slopes for beginners, especially children, served by 2 ski lifts and a moving walkway.

Day-care center from 3 years old children. **Closest car park**: Saint-Michel pay car park.

In the town center, the largest ski area for beginners and children! 4 slopes: 1 red, 1 blue and 2 green ones. Day-care center from 3 years old. Bar-restaurant, ski school, sport shop. **Free car park** at the bottom of the ski area.

At the foot of Les Grands Montets in Argentière. 2 drag lifts expect little and bigger beginners! Snack bar at the bottom of the pistes. Cross country tracks and groomed trails for walkers are to be found in the area.




Situated in hamlet Le Buet in Vallorcine, this little family friendly ski resort is a real playground!

Valid on all Chamonix ski resorts, between Le Tour / Vallorcine and Chamonix, between 1.000m and 2.700m.

Validy area:

In the mountain:

- Balme Le Tour Vallorcine
- Les Grand-Montets
- Brévent-Flégère.

Beginner / easy ski areas:

- La Vormaine
- Les Chosalets
- Le Savoy
- Les Planards.

 Free access to bus lines between Chamonix / Les Bossons and Le Tour.

• "Mont-Blanc Unlimited"

Valid on:

- all ski resorts of the valley,
- the Aiguille du Midi cable car,
- the Montenvers train,
- the Mont-Blanc Tramway.

With a 2-days or more pass, on presentation of a currentlyvalid Mont Blanc Unlimited pass and the proof of payment:

- Free and unlimited access to the Courmayeur ski resort in Italy;
- Free access to the Skyway in Italy.
 5€ deposit for the key-card;
- Access to the "Evasion Mont-Blanc" ski area : Megève, Saint-Gervais, Les Contamines and Les Portes du Mont-Blanc ;
- 1 free access to Crans-Montana ski resort in Switzerland;
- Reduction at the entrance of the Mont Blanc tunnel on the price of the one-way tickets for light-duty vehicles;
- A better fare on a bus return ticket Chamonix Courmayeur used on the same day.

With a 3 to 21 days Mont-Blanc Unlimited ski pass:

 Free access, once a day and per activity to: Richard Bozon sport center: swimming pool, sauna, hammam,

the ice-skating rinks of Chamonix and Les Houches, the museums;

- Free access to the cross-country ski resorts of the whole Chamonix valley;
- Reductions at the cinema Vox in Chamonix: 6€ the entrance (subject to agreement);
- 1 free access to the 4D cinema at the bottom of Aiguille du Midi cable car.

With a 6-days or more ski pass:

Ski in "Verbier Grand ski" in Switzerland with a 50% reduction on the normal one-day ticket. 5 CHF caution for the key-card. Conditions available once a week on presentation of a valid pass and the payment proof. Free access to:

- \checkmark bus lines in the Chamonix valley;
- ✓ buses from Compagnie du Mont Blanc between Chamonix and Megève;

✓ Mont Blanc Express trains to or from Le Fayet: please show up at the train station or go and see the train controller with your Mont Blanc Unlimited pass and your payment confirmation (cash desk ticket or E-mail confirmation) before going up in the train in order to get a valid train ticket.

If you only want to ski on the Bellevue-Prarion ski resort in Les Houches, you can buy a pass for Les Houches only!

Reduced prices if you show up with a disability card at the cash desk at the bottom of the cable cars: 50% discount on the one-day Chamonix Le Pass, Mont

Blanc Unlimited or Les Houches ski passes, as well on the excursion return tickets.

Same discount for the accompanying person if his/her presence is required.


